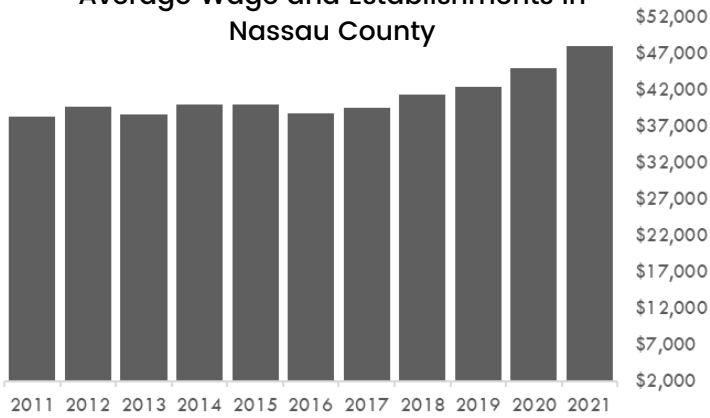

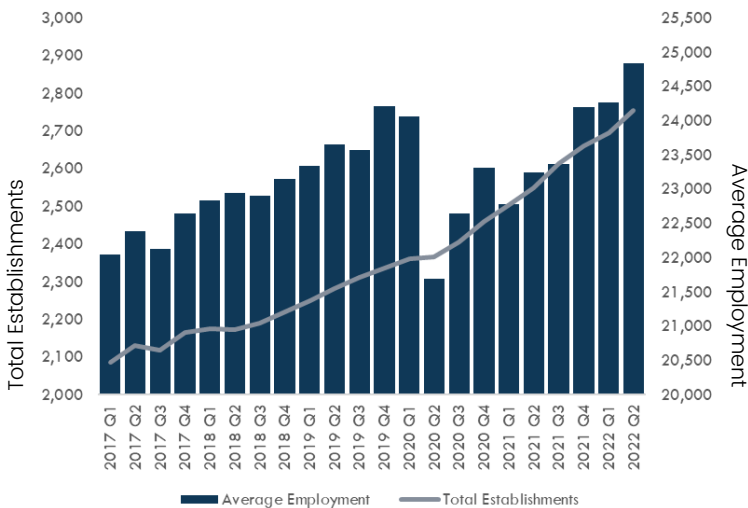
Average Wage and Establishments in Nassau County



Nassau county has been and will continue to experience major growth. Since 2013 there's been a 25.8% increase in population and an estimate of 104,200 residents by 2030.

In the last 5 years, Nassau County has seen a 23.7% increase in average wage going from \$38,847 in 2016 to \$48,091 as of 2021 Q4.

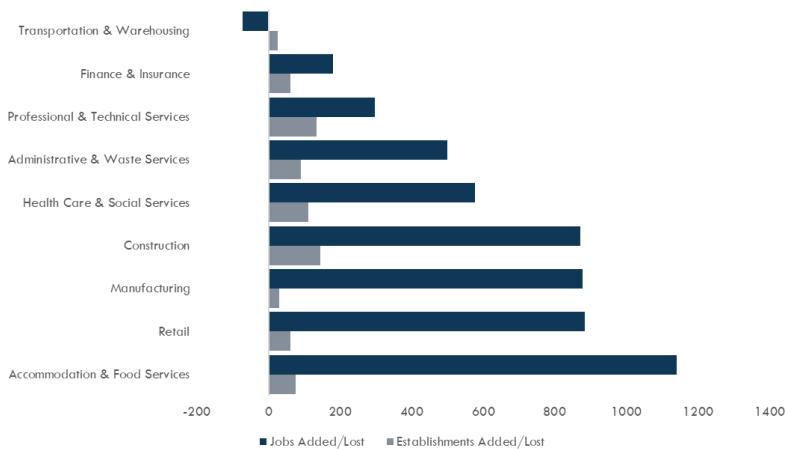
Average Employment and Total Establishments in Nassau County



Accommodations and Food Services continues to be one of the top industries in Nassau County. Over the last 10 years, there have been 1,141 jobs added.

From 2011 to 2021 average employment has increased by 11%. With the sale of the first half of the Wildlight Commerce Park in Yulee to Patillo, there's an estimate of an additional 300 jobs that will soon be created.

Job & Establishments Added/Lost in Top Industries in Nassau County (2011-2021)



In the last year (as of 2021) 285 establishments opened in Nassau County in our top 10 industries, with Administrative and Waste Services having the biggest increase, followed by Professional and Technical Services, and Accommodations and Food Services.
