ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Administered the \$4M grant Governor Ron DeSantis awarded Callahan to expand the county's infrastructure. This infrastructure project is expected to support approximately 500 jobs directly.
- Partnered with ProSky Studios to create a 3-video series to convey NCEDB's mission and role in the community with an overall theme of Nassau County, Florida's Best First Impression.
- Assisted in the finalization of the Economic Development Grant (EDG) for LignoTech of \$1.1M.
- Established the Business Retention & Expansion (BRE) Program and BRE Partners.
- Facilitated the first and second BRE Forum A Round Table Discussion for our business community to address their needs as well as how our resources and tools can adopt to fit the needs of the community; A total of 75 attendees.
- Participated in the annual Rural Counties Day held at the Capitol on behalf of Callahan and Hilliard met with State Legislators in support of Nassau County's Legislative Appropriations.

 - 562 hours spent consulting Nassau County businesses
