RISE Program

Small businesses are the cornerstone of our economy. The Nassau County RISE pilot program helps local entrepreneurs keep their capital where it belongs, in their operations.

Target: Small 'for-profit' businesses with a formal business plan.

The Benefit: Credits approved in advance, lowering the "upfront" cost of building or expanding a business.

The Incentive: Up to \$20,000 to offset County development costs (Mobility, Impact, Inspection, Application, and Permit fees).

Key Requirements: Must be working with a Nassau County representative from the Small Business Development Center (SBDC) and have a comprehensive business plan.



Schedule a Consultation

Meet with SBDC

Schedule a meeting with the Nassau County SBDC representative to review your business plan and confirm eligibility.



Submit Application

Work with the SBDC to complete your application. Once all qualifications are met, it will be submitted to Nassau County for final review.



Receive Credits

If approved, you will receive credits that can be used to cover county-related fees, such as permit, impact, mobility fees and other building-related fees.
